## YOUR RIGHTS

### Members of GEN VIC have a right to:

- Know the structure, finances and purpose of GEN VIC
- Respectfully question the work and priorities of GEN VIC and provide helpful feedback
- Be heard during discussions, meetings and forums
- State publically that you are a member of GEN VIC
- Vote at the Annual General Meetings of GEN VIC
- Nominate for a position on the Board as a Director of the organisation in accordance with the GEN VIC Constitution (organisational members)
- Be considered for skill based board positions.

## YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

### Members of GEN VIC have a responsibility to:

- Hold values that align with feminist principles
- Demonstrate ongoing support and have active personal involvement in advancing equality, health and freedom from violence against women and girls in Victoria
- Comply with the rules of GEN VIC
- Be informed about the priorities and work of GEN VIC and participate in its forums, discussions, events and activities
- Support and engage with the advocacy of GEN VIC.
